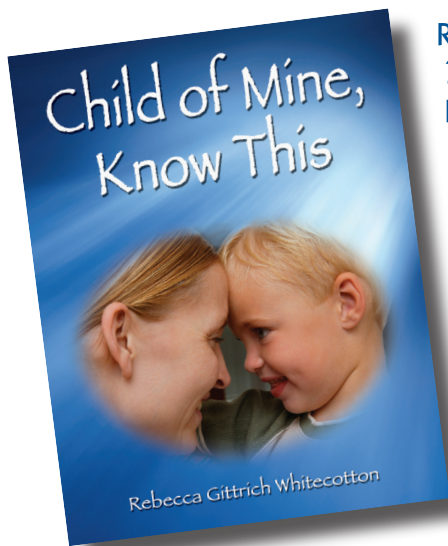


Magic, Intrigue and Illusion: Seeing Through Life's Costumes
